**NR** **Non-Retention:**  
Anglers may fish for salmon but may not retain the species (coho or chinook) listed.

**NS** **Non-Selective:**  
Anglers may keep either wild or hatchery fish.

**M** **Mark-Selective:**  
Anglers may keep hatchery salmon only and must release wild salmon. Hatchery salmon are marked with a clipped adipose fin.

**Closed:**  
Fisheries are closed to all salmon fishing when listed as such.
